How about our weather? Well, here in Fredericton we definitely have four distinct seasons with summer beginning in June. We are located along the St. John River Valley so temperatures tend to drop in the evening normally allowing for comfortable sleeping. The end of June tends to be sunny and an average of 22 degrees Celsius, which, according to the online temperature converter I found, is 71.6 degrees Fahrenheit. So, you can generally pack light clothing though you may want to also bring a sweater and pants for evenings that tend to cool down a bit. We have over 70km (44miles) of walking trails, so if you're up for it, be sure to pack some sneakers to go for a walk, run, or bike ride while you're here!



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
